Choose one of the following three topics:

1. Describe Hegel's overall project in his work "The Phenomenology of Spirit". What is he trying to do?
2. In his work "Being and Time" Heidegger is taken to reject the Cartesian distinction between subject and object as philosophically fundamental. Instead Heidegger proposes the notions of "Dasein", "care", and "being-in-the-world". Give an account of the main features of these notions.
3. Sartre's work "Being and Nothingness" defends a radical theory of human freedom. How would you characterize this theory?
