

Presentations of INF5150 Drop 2 Autumn 2006

This description is a detailing of what will happen during the presentation of the obligatory exercise drop 2 on 1. December 2006.

From the text of the obligatory exercise:

1. Each group will demonstrate briefly their system focusing on what they believe is their special assets and why their system is robust and unassailable.
2. During the evaluation of Drop 2, the evaluating group shall come up with a description of the test context in UML Testing Profile. These tests shall be performed and the results recorded. This testing process shall be briefly explained during the plenary evaluation session.

The following is a more elaborate definition of what this will mean.

Time usage

We have 3 hours each of 45 minutes. This time will be used as follows.

1. The first two hours will be used for presentations, two groups on each hour.
 - a. Each presentation of group G_x will be divided in the following way:
 - b. 7 minutes G_x demonstrates their solution and highlight their main achievements
 - c. 5 minutes G_x will present their risk analysis
 - d. 5 minutes G_y will present their tests of G_x and their criticism
 - e. 4 minutes criticism from the assistant teachers
 - f. 4 minutes criticism from the lecturers
2. In the third hour we will do the following
 - a. Technical summary of the obligatory exercise
 - b. Written evaluation of the course
 - c. Oral discussion about the course
 - d. Any technical or organizational questions

Demonstration setup

The groups are asked to run presentations and demonstrations and tests from their own laptop and their own mobile phones.

There will be one screen available for output from the running computer and another second screen to show video pictures of a mobile phone.

Review cycle

The intent was that the review cycle should be reversed on Drop 2, but because of groups 2 and 4 having merged we must deviate from that. This is the decided review cycle: G1 is reviewed by G5, G5 is reviewed by G4, G4 is reviewed by G3, G3 is reviewed by G1.

The presentation order will be that G5 presents first and G1 presents last.

Group review products

This is just to summarize what each group should do:

1. Make a demo (7 min)
2. Make a risk analysis presentation (5 min)
3. Make a test specification of the other group's product with UML Testing Profile and run the test specification.
4. Present the test specification and execute at least one test, present results (5 min). This should also include other critics.
