What are Open Web Apps?

- Web technologies to build apps haven't we covered that through phonegap?
- With Open Web Apps we aren't just talking phones, also set-top boxes, browsers etc.
- The difference between an app and a website is that you can install an app and more thoroughly integrate it into your device
- It's not a bookmark it's part of a system
- A merger of ideas! From separate Facebook Apps, Chrome Apps,
 Android Apps to a web standard for Open Web Apps
- (Future) The idea is that device functions will be Web API calls!!
 (Future 2) IoT and possibilities to run apps on Things!

Why OWA?

- Buy Once, Run anywhere!!
- WebPayment API
- Minor platform specific changes
- Standards and will allow multi-platform access

How to Make OWA?

- An Open Web App manifest contains information that a Web browser needs to interact with an app
- A file called manifest.webapp. Basic example below

```
"name": "My App",
  "description": "My elevator pitch goes here",
  "launch_path": "/",
  "icons": {
     "128": "/img/icon-128.png"
},
   "developer": {
     "name": "Your name or organization",
     "url": "http://your-homepage-here.org"
},
   "default_locale": "en"
}
```

DHIS2 Apps

- Extensions of the DHIS 2 user interface
- Clean and loosely coupled
- Can be uploaded at runtime
- Interacting with the Web API
- HTML5, Javascript and CSS only (at the moment)
- Manifest file describs the app. Based on Mozilla Open Web Apps

```
/ #html files
/manifest.webapp #manifest file
/css/ #css stylesheets
/img/ #images
/js/ #javascripts
```

DHIS2 App Manifest

```
"version": "0.1",
"name": "My app",
"description": "My app description",
"launch path": "/index.html",
"icons": {
    "16": "/img/icons/mortar-16.png",
    "48": "/img/icons/mortar-48.png",
    "128": "/imq/icons/mortar-128.png"
},
"developer": {
    "name": "Me",
    "url": "http://me.com"
"default locale": "en",
"activities": {
    "dhis": {
        "href": "*"
```
