RITMO's code of conduct can be summarized in five dimensions:

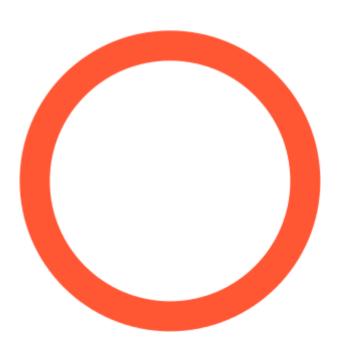


Friendliness: we are happy to share our knowledge and expertise with each other
