



ID-porten is an identification portal at the Norwegian Agency for Public Management and eGovernment (Difi) which provides secure logon with an electronic ID (e-ID) from MinID, BankID, Buypass and Commfides.

Student ID app

1) Register for the semester on Studentweb

2) Take a photo at the SiO Customer Service Centre

3) Download the student ID app called "Studentbevis"

You can download the student ID app for free from the app store on your phone.

- Windows store

4) Select "University of Oslo" as educational institution.

5) Log in with your UiO username and password.

After you have downloaded the app and logged in, it can be **used without internet** connection in the future.

- The letter will be posted to your semester address (make sure to update your Norwegian address!)
- Together with student card this is an alternative student ID.
- Always bring it with you for student discounts, also remember picture ID.

Student card

Used for:

- Extracting print-outs from campus printers
- Access card to faculty buildings
- Visit the library desk to register it as your library card

- SiO will take a picture there.


