Housing

You are prioritised for SiO housing if you:

- Apply for single furnished room
- Within the deadline 1 June
- Choose 1 August as date of arrival.
- •Please note:
 - Students are not prioritised for couples' housing.
 - You are **not** prioritised if you apply after the deadline, select a different arrival date or apply for couples' housing.

- Please contact <u>SiO Housing</u> if you require special needs provisions, i.e. due to physical disability or visual impairment.
- Always accept your offer!
- •If you do not receive a housing offer by 20 June:

How to apply for housing

How to fill in the application

- 1. Click "sign up" on the login page to create a new user:
 - Do not check the "I have a Norwegian ID number" box, or else you will not be considered an international student.
 - Fill in your date of birth by using the European date format (Day/Month//Year).
 - It is important to enter the same email address that you used when applying to studies in Søknadsweb.
- 2. Click on the activation link you receive by email and enter your personal details:
 - You must write all your first names (prénom) and family/surnames (nom de famille) exactly as stated in your Letter of admission in the "Personalia" section.
 - If you apply for housing before you are issued an admission letter, please use the name that is written in your passport.
- Choose up to 6 housing units by adding them to your wish list. Please note the following:
 - You are only prioritised for single housing units.
 - If the room you want is not available when you apply, choose the room anyway. It
 may be available when you arrive.
- 4. Go to your wishlist to start the application process:
 - Fill in these arrival dates in order to be prioritised housing:
 - 1 August (autumn semester) or
 - 1 January* (spring semester)
 - You must select "Yes" when asked: "Do you want an offer from us if we find available housing that is similar to the ones you have applied for?".
- 5. Select "The University of Oslo" as the "Study place" and submit the application.

Collecting your keys and how to get to UiO



You will be contacted by SiO housing to arrange the collection of keys



If you plan to arrive outside the opening hours, you must contact SiO to arrange for a key box. This must be arranged well ahead of your arrival.



If you arrive more than two weeks later than indicated on your tenancy contract (1 August), you must <u>notify SiO Housing</u> to avoid cancellation.

Contact SiO housing to inform them of the date of your arrival

Packing list

Remember to pack for the different seasons:

- •Oslo experiences four distinct seasons: spring, summer, autumn, and winter.
- •Summer season (June August): temperatures ranging from 15°C to 25°C (59°F to 77°F).
- •Autumn season (September to November): temperatures ranging from 10°C to 0°C (50°F to 32°F).
- •You will need the following items on arrival:
- Router and ethernet cable
- Adapter (a typical two-pin European plug)
- Bedding (duvet, pillow, sheets)
