ERC Comprehensive Review

Deliverables of a full review

- Detailed and highly critical assessment of the full proposal text, covering the formal evaluation criteria and informal priorities in as far they are known to Nehem.
- Identification of weaknesses in the proposal and concrete suggestions for improvement.
- Suggestions for editing options in case the proposal exceeds maximum page lengths as stated in the Call for proposal guidelines.
- Clear and concise comments and suggestions in the document to improve proposal structure or text to make the strongest convincing funding case for the project. And an overarching summary of feedback and next steps.
- A final consultation hour with the research to review and discuss feedback, proposing key next steps to bring the proposal forward.

Timing

This service is best implemented when the proposal is at least 85% complete. Nehem can deliver its feedback within 5 days of receipt of the proposal from the researcher, if a delivery date is agreed in advance, and schedule a follow-up consultation upon completion.
