



Utdanningsaktiviteter organisert i Open Campus

- 1. Three joint programmes on Master's or PhD level across and beyond the Knowledge Hubs
- 2. A new set of Bachelor modules on sustainability across and beyond the Knowledge Hubs
- 3. Short-term and blended flagship learning formats such as:
 - Circle U. Summer/Winter schools scaling up the existing summer schools with more participants and possible summer/winter schools organized both by the Circle U. Knowledge Hubs and outside the KH topic areas.
 - Circle U. Conversations blended and physical open "lectures" or seminars to larger audiences, in which academics and researchers engage with (non-academic) partners on a specific topic linked to our priority themes
 - Circle U. Open Courses offering online courses or modules to Circle U. students and other learners that will lead to a certificate of participation, completion, credits (similar to small MOOCs)
 - Circle U. Challenge-based learning multiplying and scaling up collaborative learning opportunities with more participants in diversified formats (hackathons, games, bootcamps, etc.) that will lead to a certificate of participation, completion, credits
 - Circle U. language and intercultural skills modules offering online and blended modules to Circle U. students and other learners to reinforce their language and intercultural competences
