We match these projects with courses at our partner schools, ensuring a strong fit between city needs and faculty expertise.

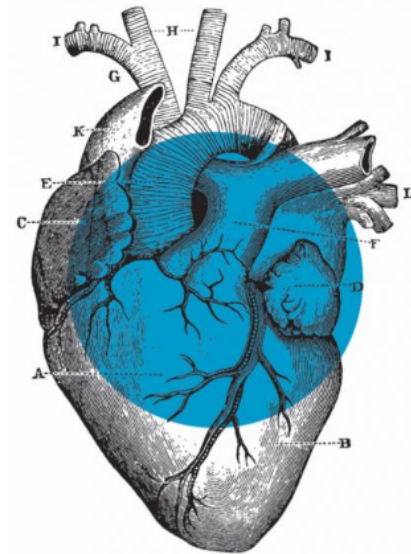


Launch Projects In Public

CityStudio Vancouver aims to shift the way students, City staff, faculty and community members work together to co-create solutions for our city.



CityStudio Vancouver launched in 2011 in collaboration with our founding partners, City of Vancouver and Simon Fraser University. We also partner with the University of British Columbia (UBC), Langara College, British Columbia Institute of Technology (BCIT), Emily Carr University of Art + Design (ECUAD) and the Native Education College (NEC).

Through the launching of experimental projects co-created together with City staff and community, university students in Vancouver have the opportunity to actively contribute to the development of their city and gain employable skills. This also inspires a culture shift in City Hall by demonstrating future possibilities and changing the way our cities are built for the better.

Guided by this theory of change, we measure our success on the quality of the projects and the strength of the relationships connecting City of Vancouver, its post-secondary institutions and the community.
