Regarding the economic impact: (1) Will fundings be provided for 250 hours of Norwegian training (UDI language requirement) for staff members, please. (2) Can staff members freely choose the course providers, please, so that a high intensity scheme (i.e., full day courses, five days a week, over a couple of months) becomes possible. [Motivation for (2): Oslo Summer School (OSS) is the default provider, but their half-day design over a whole semester proved to be too disruptive to research. Two-month high intensity modes are available from other providers, crowding out less research months. Fundings should therefore be independent of providers.]
