4. There are four traditional types of printing techniques. Which ones did Edvard Munch use and what was so new and revolutionary about his wood cuts?

5. What could be some of the main reasons for the iconic status of the painting *The Scream*?

6. What is understood by the so-called «St. Cloud manifest»?

7. What are the «Literary Diaries»?
