2. Give an interpretation of EITHER Raymond Carver's "Cathedral" OR Alice Munro's "Friend of My Youth" making sure to incorporate observations on the story's form in your analysis.
3. Both "A Horse and Two Goats" by R.K. Narayan and "Scholar and Gypsy" by Anita Desai depict American visitors to India. Compare and contrast the manner in which the two stories represent these cultural encounters.
4. Many short stories are defined by the use of an 'epiphany', which one critic has defined as moments which 'seem trivial but give away some fundamental reality'. Discuss the role of the epiphany in AT LEAST TWO short stories from the course.
