Please note: The newest browser versions of Edge and Chrome are affected by a bug in Inspira. You may experience that you delete a whole paragraph when removing content using backspace. This can be undone using the Undo buttons in the essay text editor, or ctrl+z (cmd+z for mac).

To avoid the bug completely, we strongly recommend that test takers use the newest version of Firefox (PC and Mac) or Safari (Mac).

If you want to withdraw from the examination, please click on the icon in the right corner, and then choose "withdraw".
