## Term paper (project description)

- The term paper is your project description.
- The mandatory activity for the course must have been submitted and approved before you can submit your project description.
- MEVIT and JOUR students may write their project description in a Scandinavian language or in English. Political communication-students must write their project description in English.

## Submission deadline: 18<sup>th</sup> of December 2019 at 11:00 AM (Inspera) Use 12-point font (Times, Times New Roman, Calibri) and 1,5 line spacing.

## **Project description**

Your project description includes the same sections as the thesis outline (assignment 1 in the mandatory activity).

The project description should be 5 pages long (not counting the reference/literature list) and must include:

- 1. Working title
- 2. Description of the research topic and area of interest
- 3. Literature review [review of relevant *academic* literature]
- 4. Research questions and/or hypotheses for your master's thesis
- 5. Methods and information about empirical data/material
- 6. Ethics: a brief account of ethical issues.
- 7. Reference-list with the literature used in the project description (must include at least 5 journal articles).
- 8. Literature-list: overview of the self-selected literature (400-600 pages). This list must include at least 5 journal articles (can be the same as in 7 above).
