Question 1

Then present the *Endorois case* and explain why the African Human Rights Commission found article 22 of the African Charter of Humans and People's Right on the right to development to be violated in the case. Was this a good decision from the perspective of human rights law? Give arguments that support your position.

Question 3

Choose one of the Sustainable Development Goals and discuss how the goal and its related targets can be implemented. Address the Goal from a human rights perceptive and give reasons for why / why not human rights can be invoked to give added strengths to the implementation of the Goal.
