COMPANIES VS PEOPLE

As consumers share and recycle their belongings, overall product demand might decrease. Rather than compete with other first-time sellers, companies will compete with millions of consumers willing to rent the same product for a fraction of the cost. This will drive down prices for "owned" thinge cutting into husiness's margins.

CHATBOTTING

Another way that chatbots in the sharing economy can adapt your business to current demands is by targeting niche communities and needs. On the internet, communities thrive on niche interests and preferences, which can be ignored by businesses that don't know how to scale or capitalize on those interests

With an AI-based bot, you can deliver the same content to adapt to how customers use your product or service. Using the example above, a person who sells outfits on Etsy might offer a fashion assistant who can provide tips and how-tos for pulling off a certain look.

Again, these examples show how chatbots can transform a pre-sharing economy business into one that provides specialized, peer-to-peer services to customers' tastes. Such an ability is essential in the sharing economy.

BYOM! at H&M Measure Kiosks: The fashion giant does not want your body scan data.

Swedish fast-fashion supergroup H&M is not taking its Pinwheel 10 membership lightly. Despite the uproar, the fashion brand is sticking by its decision to not provide data storage in their public "H&M Measure" scan kiosks.

Kendra Kjassellö, head of data protection, H&M issued a press release regarding their commitment towards preventing misuse of sensitive details via their popular public body scan and measure kiosks: "... Measure kiosks require physical body details for perfect tailoring offered to our consumers. These kiosks are used by adults as well as minor children. We at H&M fully understand the importance and criticality of keeping this data confidential. We are not using this data for any other purpose and have decided not to store it in our servers. Even with our state of the art digital securities, we value mutual trust. We have found keeping the data with the consumers, helps us retain this trust as well as protect their interest better. Consumers can use our complimentary highencryption felt memory patch at the kiosk."





EU warns Samsung on blocking third party resale markets APIs in their sold products.

BRUSSELS (Reuters) - The European Union gave Samsung an ultimatum on Thurday: Let users freely transact their fairly purchased and owned Samsung products on digital reselling platforms or face sanctions.

The IOT and smart tech companies are under pressure in Europe with the rise of third party digital reselling platforms as source of raw material deposits. Reality check movement and mineral scarcity has also aggravated the situation.

The EU has been in talks with the Samsung for almost two years because it says the tech giant is yet to fully comply with its consumer protection rules.

The issue was taken up by the union after several consumer complaints as well as an open petition by Nearby Digitals about their Samsung smart devices failed to auto-list on popular reselling platforms such Nearby, Curate and several others. The committe noted that consumers were unware of any such clause while purchasing the item and that it is not listed as part of the terms and conditions.

"Companies cannot dictate the usage and resale of their sold products." the consumer protection authorities stated. The European Commission warned Samsung and other tech companies from indulging into anti competitive practices and clearly inform users about any digital resale restriction options in a clear way to the consumers before selling the product.

The commission will hold a news conference on the issue at 0815 GMT on Thursday.


