Oblig 5: Synchronization

Further requirements

- The program should print good error messages, e.g., if it is given incorrect/missing parameters.
- Use good programming style, e.g., proper indentations, good variable names, etc.
- The report **MUST** be handed in as a PDF file.
- All submitted files should be contained in a single zip-file.

The report must contain:

1. Introduction – *what this report is about*
2. User guide – *how to run your program (short, but essential), include a very simple example. Do not forget to describe the parameter line arguments to the program. Also include any instructions necessary to BUILD the program*
3. Explain how you did the synchronization – *consider including drawings*
4. Implementation – *a somewhat detailed description of how your Java program works*
5. Testing – *how did you test the program? Provide convincing test output*
6. Conclusion – *just a short summary of what you have achieved*
