## Report description IN5510 2023

The report deadline is Friday November 24 at 14:00. Submit by email to <u>guribv@ifi.uio.no</u> and <u>toraja@ifi.uio.no</u>.

This is a description of the expected contents and size of the report. The report shall include the following:

- Introduction / Background and problem area A background to the problem area is described to give an introduction to why the group chose this specific problem. The background description leads to the project's selection of the target group and design objectives.
- Case and context
   The context where the project has been carried out is described, including a rich description of the participants.
- The design process and prototypes

  Describe the process and prototype(s): how the project was carried out, which methods
  and techniques you used, your design choices and the prototypes you worked with.
- Analysis and discussion
  Give an analysis of the design process and/or the results and discuss it with the help of concepts and theories from the curriculum.
- Individual reflections

  Each group member writes at least 1,5 pages of text, reflecting over the project and your experience, using the perspectives, approaches and methods included in the curriculum, referencing some of the literature. (We prefer that these are submitted as appendixes to the group report, but they may also be handed in separately from the report itself.)

The report must contain at least 6000 words and max 10000 words of text with font Times New Roman 12, single space. Write group number, project name and member names at the front page. The individual reflections are not included in the word count. The file name will be on the form "project\_report\_group\_X".

The project is mandatory. You must complete the project and write and submit the report together with your group to take the oral exam.
