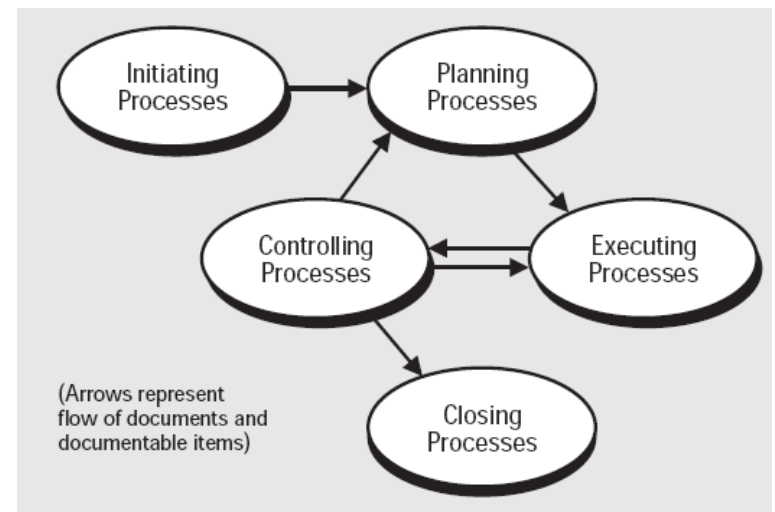

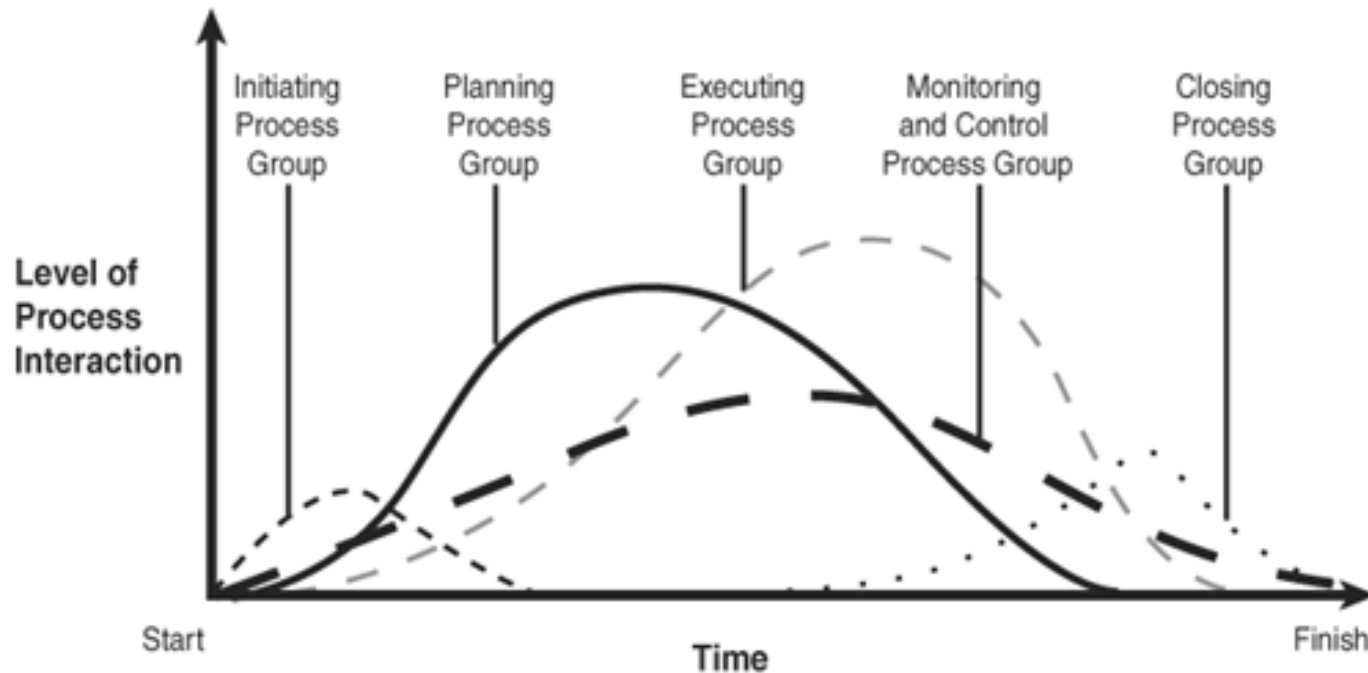
- Project – Program – Portfolio

Five PM Process Groups (42 processes)

- **Initiating (2)**
 - define new project or project phase
- **Planning (20)**
 - establish scope, refine objective, define course action, costs, schedule etc.
- **Executing (8)**
 - processes to complete the work
- **Monitoring & Controlling (10)**
 - track, review, & regulate progress
- **Closing (2)**
 - finalize all activities



PM Process Groups - discrete or overlapping activities?
