



Five PM Process Groups (42 processes)

- Initiating (2)
 - define new project or project phase
- Planning (20)
 - establish scope, refine objective, define course action, costs, schedule etc.
- Executing (8)
 - processes to complete the work
- Monitoring & Controlling (10)
 - track, review, & regulate progress
- Closing (2)
 - finalize all activities
