Your project is very interesting. The report is well-written and composed in an easily readable manner. We get the impression that you have spent a reasonable amount of time working on the project. We feel, however, that the definition of the problem area could have been more thorough. At the same time we also feel that there's a lack of theory regarding the project, and perhaps referring more to books and articles you've read would give it a stronger academic foundation.

It's good that you use different methods for obtaining information, and your observations are interesting. At the same time we would like to know more about how you decided on the different activities (eating/drinking, reading, waiting) and how you have defined "just wait" in your project.

We feel that your user group may be a bit too loosely defined. "Basically the user group for the project is all travellers, but above all especially new travellers." Since your project are regarding Blindern station it would perhaps make more sense to limit yourself to students travelling with the subway, with your main focus being on new students (?).

It's good that you have thought about different screens for maps and information and the quiz. The only drawback we see is that having only one screen of each might lead to queues in front of the screens, and making it difficult for everyone to get a chance to play. The documentation was a bit unclear on whether you planned to have the sub-way map on a screen of its own, but since you've proposed different screens for the other two features it would make sense to continue with this practice. At the same time we wonder if perhaps it would make more sense to make a cut-out of the subway map, so the areas closer to Blindern are present, but not the stations further away. This would make it easier to read, and probably also be of greater interest for the users. You might also consider distinguishing the T-bane lines in some way (e.g. by using different colors on the dots). By the way, real time information on the T-bane will be available on the Internet before Christmas, according to Trafikanten.

All in all we find your project and report very interesting.
