ABOUT MAT2000 - PROSJEKTARBEID I MATEMATIKK

1. What is MAT2000

In the project course MAT2000 you will pick a project and an advisor, and you will work with him/her on this project throughout the semester. After a few introductory lectures, including a crash course in laTex and a library course, a number of candidate advisors will present their suggestions for projects, and you can then pick the project you find most interesting. However, each advisor only has the capacity to guide a limited number of students (depending on the advisor), so the projects are assigned on a first-come first-served basis. Alternatively, if you have a good idea for a project, you can try to find an advisor yourself. Your course leader can help you to find suitable candidates.

Apart from the main project, the course includes a mandatory assignment - see the link on the web page for details.

There will be no ordinary teaching during this course. After the advisors are done presenting their projects and you have picked one, you will start working with him/her. Towards the end of the semester (see the web page for details) you will hand in your written assignment, and then the final exam will be an oral presentation of your project.

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
