## Written assignment

The written part of the mandatory assignment is expected to be written as a scientific paper, including an abstract, introduction and necessary background and notation. It is expected that you give a clear presentation with all necessary explanations. Remember to include all relevant plots and figures.

All aids, including collaboration, are allowed, but the submission must be written by you and reflect your understanding of the subject.

Parts of the mandatory assignment may be reused in the final project.

### Formal requirements for the written assignment

The assignment should be:

- Written in LATEX
- 2–3 pages (A4, font size 10)

The assignment must contain the following:

- Title
- Abstract
- Introduction
- The chosen topic or result
- A picture, illustration, figure, graph or table
- Clickable cross references
- Clickable citations and references in the text in a chosen style
- Bibliography in a chosen style
