

Information to students and teachers about the examination

The previously suggested construction of examination for Module 6 did not fulfil the formal requirements, since it merges to types of examinations into one. In dialogue with the Faculty, we have decided to discard the oral examination. We apologize for this change, which however should have no consequences for your preparations. Further information will be given at a separate Zoom-meeting Friday 8/5 and at the scheduled information about exam 4/6.

The only examination this semester will be a digital home examination with contents corresponding to about half of the ordinary, in half of the time. Consequently, there will be 65-70 questions over 2 hours (103-110 s/question).

The questions will be non-sequential and include a mixture of multiple choice, multiple response and pull-down questions, delivered to the students in a randomized order. The order of answering options will also be randomized, and the questions should be solved one-by-one. Any cooperation/communication with other individuals, screenshots and use of mobile phones is prohibited.

As the home-exam lacks validation, no grades will be given, and the ordinary intention of around 60% score to pass will be adjusted according to the psychometric results. We will arrange a re-sit 12/8.

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
