

Case tasks summary course obstetrics and gynecology, May/June 2021

Task 1

Healthy 35-years-old woman, G2P0, contacts you in your GP office because of smelly discharge and minor vaginal bleeding after a holiday in Greece. She admits having unprotected intercourse during her holiday. Her last pelvic examination was performed five years ago.

Your tasks are to:

- Make a plan
- Perform a pelvic examination with relevant tests. What tests will you take?
- Suggest other tests to perform?
- Suggest the most likely diagnosis and the differential diagnoses?

Task 2

A 48-year-old woman G4P3, presents in your GP office with intermenstrual bleeding for 2 months. Episodes of bleeding occur any time in the cycle. This is usually fresh blood and much lighter than a normal period. It can last for 1-6 days. There is no associated pain. She has no hot flushes or night sweats. She is sexually active and has not noticed vaginal dryness. Her smear was tested 2.5 years ago and was normal. She is healthy and uses no medication.

Your tasks are to:

- Perform a pelvic examination with relevant tests. What tests will you take?
- Suggest the most likely diagnosis and the differential diagnoses?
- Suggest further investigation and management in this woman?
