Learning from case «A heart on fire...»

- Management of an incidental finding
- Incidental findings are usually less urgent than presentation by symptoms
- · Beware of the tracks you make by your advices!

Little Simz

Learning from the case «It must be a camel»

- Things are not always as they seem!
- This case includes acute symptoms of bronchiolitis (incl. desaturation) added to heart failure symptoms

Frank Zappa

- · Heart failure symptoms are unspecific
- Co-morbidity may obscure clinical pictures
- Heart defects may present during infections

Learning from case «Running around in circles...» and «Double up»)

- Reflection on different anatomies
- Neonatal pathophysiology; a duct-dependent pulmonary circulation in the first case
- The second case illustrates one of the few situations with combined heart failure and cyanosis
- Prediction of symptoms from a hemodynamic background
