Clinical small group teaching at the Department of Pediatrics.

You should bring your stethoscope, oto-ophthalmoscope, indoor shoes and if you have them, ID card and instruction material. Change to white clothes before meeting.

Pediatric clinical examination and introduction

Presentation of the Department for Child and Youth Medicine (Barne- og Ungdomsklinikken, BUK) and introduction to the clinical program and education in clinical skills. Demonstration of history taking and examination of a child. Responsible are the Research Fellows (kliniske stipendiater) at BUK & Faculty Division at AHUS.

When and where: 31 August 2015, time 13.30-15.30 for students K146-154 and 2 November 2015, time: 13h-15h for students K46-53. Meet at the UiO area at BUK 1st floor. **Mandatory.**

Small group instruction on the wards (CW)

Teaching by the Professor or Research Fellows given in groups of two students. The focus will be on history taking and examination of children at various ages.

Where and when: See clinical rotation table below. Meet at the UiO area BS02.33 1st floor (andre etasje) at 09:00. CW is **Mandatory** from 09:00. Please attend the doctor's morning meeting at BS02.43 at 08.00-09:00.

Outpatient clinics (OC). Meet a medical doctor at the outpatient clinic. Thereafter you will accompany a doctor during his/her consultations.

Where and when: Meet at the outpatient clinic ground floor (Barnepoliklinikken) at 08.30. Before this you may follow the doctor's morning meeting. This starts at 08.00 and lasts until 09.00 at room BS02.43, 1st floor (andre etasje). **Mandatory at the outpatient clinic** from 08.30 or 09:00.

Supervision by nurses (SN) in equipment and medication devices for treatment of obstructive lung disease and diabetes. Where and when: Outpatient Clinic – ground floor. Time will be decided later. **Not Mandatory.**

Health center (HC): Look up the different times and locations in the Health Center (Helsestasjon) information booklet or at the internet. **Mandatory.**

Independent self-study (ISS). This learning method is based on the student's participation in the regular work of the department. You will be expected to attend the morning meeting at 08.00 in the meeting room at the UiO area at BUK 1st floor (andre etasje) at 08.00. Thereafter you will take part in the respective wards for the pre-round and round (visit) and take part in the daily work on the wards. Under guidance by the professor you are expected to take the initiative to contact patients and parents for medical history examination and also to physically examine patients on your own initiative. The specific patients will be discussed afterwards. Always contact the responsible nurse on the wards, and if possible your resident tutor, before approaching patients/parents. **Not mandatory.**

Case Meeting (CM): At BS02.33 1st floor (andre etasje). To give a presentation on a medical subject, alternatively to orally present a written record of one patient. When and where: **TO BE DECIDED LATER** by students and professor Nakstad (93404858/ britt.nakstad@medisin.uio.no) **Presentation at the case meeting is mandatory and is not included in the general rule of 20% absence**

Written patient record: Each student should make at least one written record based on examination of a patient in the department with a pediatric diagnosis. This can be done when following a doctor on call. Please bring a copy of the record for assessment and assignment. **Presentation of a written patient record is mandatory and is not included in the general rule of 20% absence**
