Question 1

Discuss how small farmers in sub-Saharan Africa cope with seasonal hunger. What is the development role of social protection and cash transfers for this group of people in the short and long term?

**Or**

Question 2

The AIDS epidemic has peaked in southern Africa but there is still a relatively high number of new HIV infected young people. Discuss how cash transfers can contribute to a reduction in this number.
