2A. Outline main characteristics of contemporary Norwegian/Nordic parenthood policies. Discuss trends towards individualization and familization in these policies and implications for gender equality.

OR:

2B. Outline gender divisions of domestic labour in Norway/Nordic countries. Discuss social conditions that may generate these patterns.
