- a. Essentially true. Tirole secs 5.2.1 and 5.3. (The question does not ask for the Cournot equilibrium, so most of the answer can be found in sec 5.2.1.)
- b. This all depends. Many would say it is false, based on the treatment in the textbook, but that assessment hinges on some conditions. Tirole, sec 7.1.1.
- c. Essentially true. Tirole, sec 6.3.1.
- d. Essentially true. Tirole, secs 6.3.3 and 6.7.1.1. (This question is hard, so also good verbal discussions, based on sec 6.3.3, can get top grades.)
- e. This all depends. Tirole, sec. 10.1.
- f. Under some standard assumptions, this is true. Klemperer.
