Exam in the Master Course Selection and Development

Individual part: Case

Select one of the two options of the exam case that you find on Canvas. Use the textbook and the scientific literature of the course (on Canvas) for the analysis of the case. This part of the exam should not exceed 3000 words.

This part of the exam is graded anonymously. Write your candidate number that you find in StudentWeb (do not use your name) and course code on the front page of your assignment. Be aware that individual home exams are screened for plagiarism.

Group part: Documentation of learning activity

Each work group hands-in a full documentation of the learning activity that contains:

- a. All material used for the learning activity in class,
- b. The time planning for delivering the learning activity
- c. Additional explanations of the material and the procedure whenever necessary, including any additional information on how the steps of the learning activity were performed
- d. Information about the scientific background of the learning activity (about 1 page), in more detail, this scientific text consists of arguments and theory regarding the topic of the learning activity (e.g., personality tests).
- e. Information on why the steps of the learning activity were planned that way (about 1 page), in more detail, this scientific text consists of arguments and theory regarding the HRD background of this learning activity.

The documentation is complete if it allows others to repeat this learning activity without any further explanations. It refers to scientific literature that has not been used in the course whenever it is helpful. APA style is used for referencing.

The administration told me to inform you about the following: "All candidates must submit the assignment in Inspera. Please write the candidate numbers of all members of your group on the front page. For example: 'Written group exam in PSY4420, candidate 10, 11 and 12.' The assignment is anonymous and must not contain your name, only your candidate number."
