



Agreement of supervision Department of Social Anthropology

This agreement specifies the supervision between

With regards to the master project:

Supervision between supervisor and student is regulated in *Ethical guidelines for supervisors at the University of Oslo*. The supervisor is expected to know these guidelines.

Scope and limitations

The scope of supervision is limited to a total of 13 meetings: 3 meetings while development the project proposal in the first semester. 1 consultation before fieldwork during the second semester, 1 during fieldwork and 8 meetings during the writing up period of the master project; 2 in the third semester and 6 in the fourth semester. If the supervisor in preparation for the meeting reads more than 50 pages of the students written work, the meeting counts as two meetings. Unused meetings cannot be transferred to later semester. In total, the student has the right to supervision in 4 semesters, including the field work/ data collecting

If the student for a period does *not* want supervision, the department and the supervisor must be notified. If the students fails to do so, the semester counts as part of the total right to supervision.

If the supervisor is unavailable for a period, the department will ensure that supervision will be offered. Meetings already held, is subtracted from the total amount of meetings in the case of change of supervisor.

Termination for the agreement

The agreement is terminated when:

- a) the student finishes the final examination of the master degree.
- b) the student changes supervisor
- c) the student has had all the total amount of supervision meetings and/or four semesters or if
- d) the admission to the master programme is revoked, or
- e) the student withdraws from the study programme
