### Exam regulations for the Project Proposal, Autumn 2020

#### Specific requirements:

The scope of the Project Proposal is 3500 words +/- 10% (excluding references).

Write in font size 12, with 1.5 line break.

You may submit your response in English only.

#### The project proposal should contain the following elements:

- Background
- Research questions, place/empirical field
- Relevant literature and previous research within the field (remember to reference correctly and list all references in the reference list)
- Methods
- Ethical issues
- Project timeline
- Reference list

#### The exam paper must:

- Have numbered pages
- Have a cover page which specifies
  - Total number of words
  - The course code and title
  - Semester and year (e.g. Autumn 2020)
  - Your candidate number in the upper right-hand corner. Do **NOT** write your name in your exam paper. You find your candidate number in the StudentWeb.
- Meet the correct word count stated above, or may be rejected administratively.
- Be uploaded as one **PDF** file in Inspira before the announced deadline.

#### Sources, referencing and cheating:

Exam papers must be written in accordance with guidelines for citations and use of sources.
