- **Submission deadline:** [November 11 at 2 PM \(Norwegian time\)](#)
- **Assessment:** The Research Project Proposal is assessed by the supervisor and graded on a pass/fail basis

### **The Research Project Proposal should contain the following elements:**

- Background
- Research questions, place/empirical field
- Relevant literature and previous research within the field (remember to reference correctly and list all references in the reference list)
- Methods
- Ethical issues
- Project timeline
- Reference list

  - The course code and title
  - Semester and year

- Meet the correct word count stated on the previous page, or may be rejected administratively.
- Be uploaded as one **PDF** file in Inspera before the announced deadline.
