- Remember to add your **course code, date** in the header. Use the title "**Final reflection paper in Anthropological Methods**".
- Times New Roman, 12 font size, Line spacing 2.0 . Insert page numbers and a correct list of references.
- You must submit your paper as a **PDF file** in Inspira before the announced deadline.
- Make sure your **submission is anonymous** - do not use your name in your assignment or in the file name. You find your candidate number in StudentWeb.
