Assessment guidelines – ANTH4030 Autumn 2020

For the final exam of ANTH4030, students have been asked to upload <u>three</u> revised reflection papers, previous versions of which they have produced during the semester. The selection of papers was left up to the students.

The students were also given the option to draw on three reflection papers in <u>one</u> single essay discussing the implications for their planned fieldwork.

While the pass/fail scale is applied as an independent scale with only two possible results, and is not connected to the letter grades, the following guidelines below explain the criteria used to determine whether a paper is a "pass" or "fail".

Pass

A document containing three reflection papers or one essay that draws on three reflection papers that critically engage with the readings done during the semester. The grading range here encompasses everything from an excellent to a satisfactory grasp of the topics represented during the three chosen weeks of the term.

Fail

A document containing an insufficient number of reflection papers; or a document that shows very little or no understanding of the topics represented during the three chosen weeks of the term.
