Specific requirements:

You are to submit in **one** PDF file: three short and revised texts/reflection papers (approximately 300 words each) relating to topics covered in three separate weeks of the course. You choose which three papers.

Exams at the University of Oslo may be checked for correct word count. Papers which do not meet the requirement will not be graded.

The exam papers must be uploaded before the announced deadline.

You may submit your response in English, Norwegian, Swedish or Danish.

Exam papers must:

- Have numbered pages.
- Have a font size and line spacing which makes it easy to read.
- Have a cover page which specifies:
 - Total number of words for each text
 - The course code and title
 - Semester and year
 - Your candidate number. Do **NOT** write your name in your exam paper. You find your candidate number in Studentweb.
- Be uploaded as **one** PDF file in Inspera.
