Exam regulations for the take home exam, Spring 2022

Specific requirements:

The exam paper consists of three short texts (approximately 300 words each) relating to topics covered in three separate weeks of the course of your choice.

You may submit your response in English, Norwegian, Swedish or Danish.

Exam papers must:

- Have numbered pages
- Have a font size and line spacing which makes it easy to read
- Have a cover page which specifies:
 - Total number of words for each text
 - The course code and title
 - Semester and year
 - Your candidate number in the upper right-hand corner. Do **NOT** write your name in your exam paper. You find your candidate number in the StudentWeb.
- Be uploaded as **one** PDF file in Inspira before the announced deadline.
