 - Your candidate number. **Do not write your name in your exam paper.** You will find your candidate number in studentweb
- You may write your examination paper in Norwegian, Swedish, Danish or English.
- Make sure your submission is anonymous do not use your name in your assignment or in the file name
- You are only allowed to submit one file and it needs to be in PDF-format.
