TSD Export Auditing

Principles

- Importing is simple.
- Exporting is rare.
- Export requires auditing.



Design implications

- Tailored towards project administrators.
- “**Who** did **what** at **what time**?”
- Limit the type of operations to retrieval.
- Filter by user and time period.

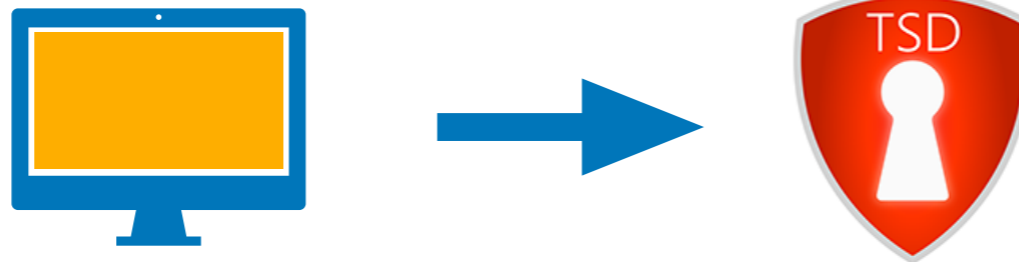

Synopsis

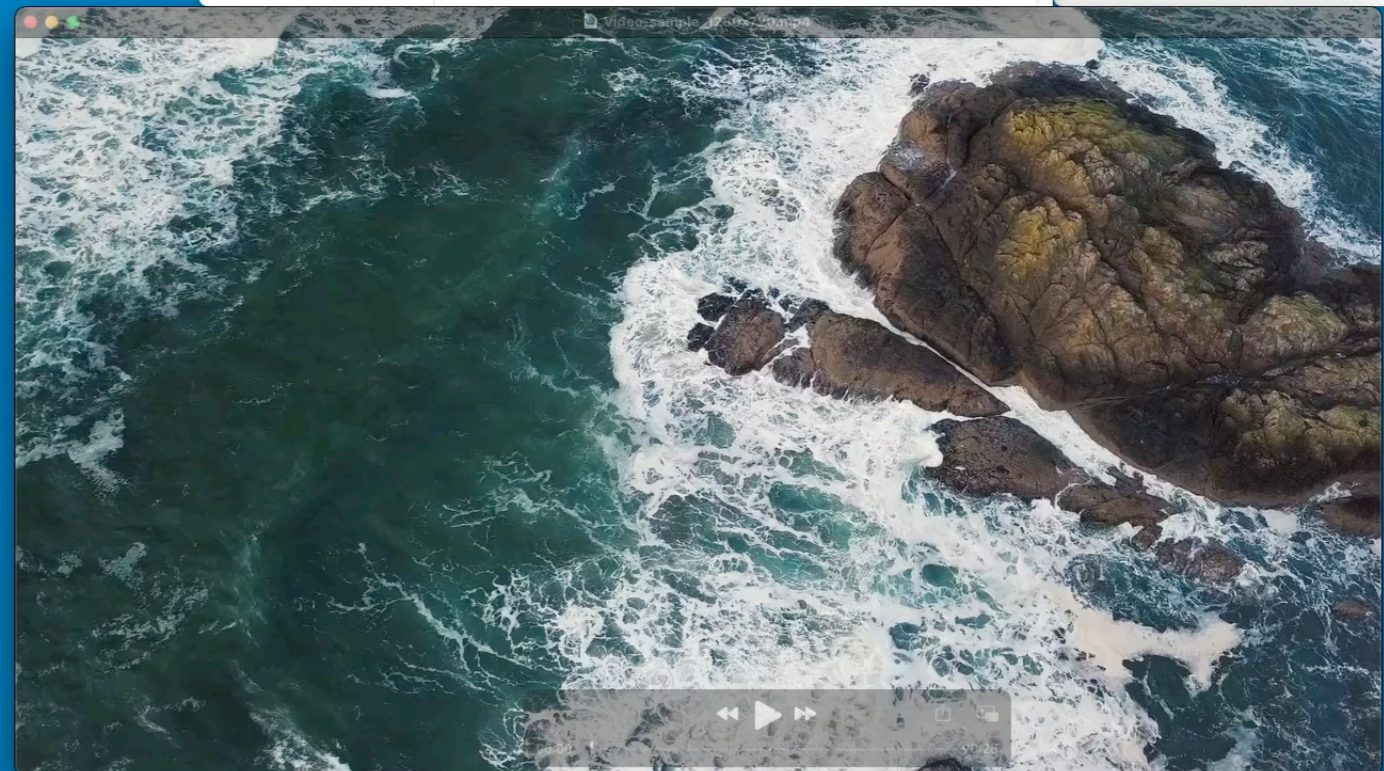
- Screen capturing into TSD.
